

- 9.3 The Chairman of the Committee on Budget, Finance and Appropriation of the Sangguniang Bayan, as Member;
- 9.4 The District Supervisors of the Department of Education presently assigned in Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur, as Members;
- 9.5 The Executive Director of PNU-Mindanao, Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur, as member;
- 9.6 The Municipal Treasurer, as member;
- 9.7 The President, Prosperidad Administrators' Association of Secondary Schools, as member
- 9.8 The Federation President of the General PTA- Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur;
- 9.9 The Secretary to the Sangguniang Bayan, as Member-Secretariat;

SECTION 10. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SCHOLARSHIP SCREENING COMMITTEE. The Committee shall be tasked and be responsible for the following;


- 10.1 Formulate the Rules and Regulations for the effective implementation of this ordinance;
- 10.2 Disseminate information, accept and process all applications related to this program;
- 10.3 Prepare the test questionnaires and conduct competitive examinations both written and oral for all applicants every 3rd Tuesday of April of every year;
- 10.4 Recommend to the Sangguniang Bayan within Thirty (30) days after the conduct of Competitive Examination through a committee resolution the names of successful applicants who could be accommodated to this program;
- 10.5 Recommend to the Sangguniang Bayan, through a committee resolution the names of grantees who should be disqualified for having committed or incurred the disqualifications stated in section 5 hereof;
- 10.6 Evaluate the performance, and determine the eligibility of the grantees and recommend to the Sangguniang Bayan, through a committee resolution, their continued scholarship eligibility at the beginning of every semester.

10.7 Through the Municipal Treasurer's Office, the committee shall be charged for the preparation of vouchers and other related documents necessary for the disbursement of funds relative to the grants herein mentioned.

SECTION 12. DISBURSEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP FUND. No scholarship fund shall be disbursed without a Sangguniang Bayan Resolution passed and approved for the purpose. Unused funds out of the amount herein appropriated shall be reverted back to the general fund at the end of every calendar year.

SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect on the first semester of the School Year 2018-2019, and shall remain effective every school year thereafter, until amended, revised or superseded.



SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Establishing a College Scholarship Program for the Less Fortunate but Deserving Students in the Municipality of Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur".

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is the policy of the Municipal Government of Prosperidad to support students who cannot afford to go to college especially those who achieved academic excellence, free education through its scholarship program.

SECTION 3. MAXIMUM NUMBER OF GRANTEES PER SCHOOL YEAR. Beginning School Year 2018-2019, and every School Year thereafter, the municipal government shall grant a maximum of ten (10) scholars. In no case, however, shall the number of grantees reach more than forty (40) in any school year.

SECTION 4. QUALIFICATIONS. The recipient of the Scholarship Program shall have the following qualifications;

- 4.1 Must be a Filipino Citizen and a bonafide resident of the Municipality of Prosperidad, Province of Agusan del Sur for two (2) years prior to the date of application;
- 4.2 Must be morally upright and no pending cases in any court in the country;
- 4.3 Must not be over 30 years old at the time of application;
- 4.4 Must be a High School Graduate at the time of application, with a general average of at least 85% or its equivalent;
- 4.5 Must hail from a family whose combined annual gross income of parents should not be more than PhP 150,000.00 at the time of application.
- 4.6 Must pass the written and oral examination to be conducted by the Scholarship Screening Committee.

SECTION 5. DISQUALIFICATIONS. Grantees to this scholarship program shall be deemed automatically disqualified when any of the following is committed, omitted or incurred;

- 5.1 When convicted by a court of law for infraction of any law in the Philippines or abroad;
- 5.2 Flunking in any of the subjects enrolled for the semester;
- 5.3 Dropping of any subject as reflected in His/Her final grades.
- 5.4 Failure to submit final grades in all subjects thirty (30) days after the last date of final examinations, unless for valid reason. He/She shall be required to submit letter of consideration to the Scholarship Screening Committee;

- 5.5 Any grantee that is below the regular number of subjects or units on the prospectus prescribed by the School.

SECTION 6. COURSES TO TAKE UP AND SCHOOL TO ENROLL IN.

Successful applicants shall take up any Four (4) year baccalaureate courses being offered in any State or Private Colleges and Universities within CARAGA Region and shall maintain an average rating of 85% up to its graduation.

SECTION 7. SCHOLARSHIP COVERAGE. The Scholarship fund herein established and appropriated covers only for the following nature of disbursements for each grantee, viz;

- 7.1 **Entrance Fee** (For Freshmen – First Semester only) ₱500.00 per grantee;
- 7.2 **Miscellaneous Fees**, ₱500.00 per grantee per Semester;
- 7.3 **Tuition Fees**, ₱15,000.00 per grantee per Semester;
- 7.4 **Laboratory Fees**, ₱1,000.00 per grantee per Semester;
- 7.5 **Monthly Cash Allowance**(Boarding & Lodging), ₱5,000.00 per grantee per Month
- 7.6 **Book Allowance**, PhP1,000.00 per grantee per Semester;
- 7.7 **Uniform Allowance**, PhP1,500.00 per grantee per School Year;

SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION OF FUND. There is hereby appropriated, effective calendar year 2018 and cumulative every budget year thereafter, the amount chargeable against the General Fund of the municipal government, and shall be deposited as trust fund and disbursed only for purposes of this ordinance, viz;
